






Military Medical Divided by Services







Why have SME Encounter Sessions?

 First & foremost: build collaborations for developing medical capabilities and products the military can use

 Share info on military interests, ability to support, who to work with to develop, and who to engage for end user feedback

 Obtain/provide feedback on ideas, pitches, early proposals, current products vs customer discovery of prospective products

 Help define what successful outcomes would look like

 Ability to meet with Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) from 3 services & VA at the same time



What are SME Encounter Sessions:

- Meet with a panel of SMEs about a particular medical topic of interest to military (and others)
- SME panel composed of representatives from Naval Medical Research Unit - San Antonio (NAMRU-SA), U.S. Army Institute of Surgical Research (USAISR), 59th Medical Wing Science & Technology (59 MDW/ST), and Veterans Affairs (VA)
- May also include an end user representative
- 10-minute time slots available to meet & discuss shared interests
- Time slots assigned during online preregistration – some fill up fast!



Where are SME Encounter Session:

- Held in adjoining room to SA AIM Health R&D summit meetings
- Tables will be arranged to provide some privacy
- Tables will be clearly labeled with the SME panel topic
- A check in table will be outside the designated room for registrants to check in >5 minutes before appointment and stage for their presentation
- Topics vary from day 1 to day 2



Rules of Engagement (ROE):

 Any confidential information <u>must be</u> <u>identified/labeled</u> so panel will protect it from unintentional disclosures

 Okay to bring prototypes provided they are safe and do not take a long time to set up
